

## **Hearing Sounds in Sentences Check-Up**

- 1. Give your child a blank sheet of paper and a pencil.
- 2. Tell your child, "I am going to read a sentence. Then I will read the sentence VERY SLOWLY, word by word, so that you can write down the words in the sentence. "
  (You can help your child with a few prompts, "Say the word out loud it might help." or "How would you start to write that word?" or "What can you hear?" "We will move on to the next word.")
- 3. After your child is done tell them what a great job they have done.
- 4. Score your child's work by giving one point for ever sound (phoneme) your child wrote correctly.

\*Additions or Omissions-If the letter is not marked on the Check-Up sheet then it receives NO score. Additions DO NOT affect scoring as long as listed letters are included.

\*<u>Capital Letters</u>-Substitutions for upper and lower case letters are acceptable.

\*<u>Substitutions</u>- Substitutions are acceptable if the sound is sometimes recorded that way.

\*Changes in Letter Order-When there is a change in letter order, take one point off for that word.
