

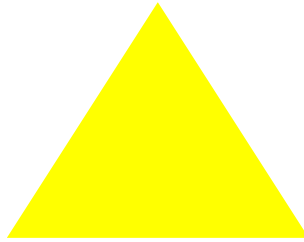
Finding the Perimeter

The perimeter is the total distance around the outside of a 2D shape. You get the perimeter by adding up all the sides of the shape.

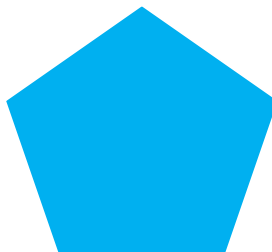
The Perimeter of a square = + + +
