

Check-Up for Money

- *Run off Counting Pennies, Nickels, and Dimes. Ask your child to count so many pennies, then nickels, and then dimes.
- 0 My child understands how to and can count pennies, nickels, and dimes.
- *Run off Counting Quarters and Counting Half Dollars. Ask your child to count so many quarters and so many half dollars.
- 0 My child understands how to and can count quarters and half dollars.
- *Run off the game Counting Coins. Play the game with your child asking them to count many different combinations of coins.
- 0 My child understands how to and can count combinations of coins accurately.
- *Run off the game, How Much Money? Play the game with your child asking them to count and then write the amount of money.
- 0 My child can count the money and can write the amount of money accurately.
- *Play the game Store with your child. Ask them to give you change after you tell them how much you purchased.
- 0 My child can make change accurately.
- *Play the game Rounding Money to the Nearest Dollar.
- 0 My child understands and can round money to the nearest dollar.
