## Making Numbers

Before Playing:

1. Run off the Tens and Ones Making Numbers game board.
2. Run off the tens and ones numbers and cut them apart.

## Directions:

1. Put a number in the ones column. Ask, "What number do I have in the ones column?"
2. Put the number 5 in the ones column and $\qquad$ number in the tens column counting up by 10's. (Example: 5, 15, 25, 35, 45 ...)
3. Put $\qquad$ numbers in the ones column and $\qquad$ numbers in the tens column. Add and subtract using the numbers. Make sure you are using forward counting and counting backward so your child is very familiar with place value through the hundreds.

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
