

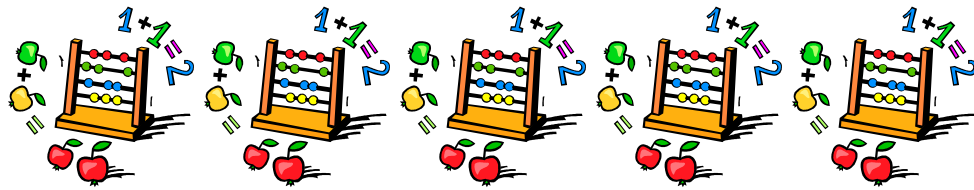
Tens and Ones

Before Playing:

1. Run off the Tens and Ones game.
2. Run off the tens and ones counters and cut apart.

Games:

1. Put ____ counters in the ones column. Ask, "How many counters do I have in the ones column?"
2. Put ____ counters in the ones column and add tens in the tens column counting up by 10's. (Example: 5, 15, 25, 35, 45 ...)
3. Put ____ counters in the ones column and add tens in the tens column counting up and then take tens away counting backwards. (Example: 7, 17, 27, 37, 47, 37, 27, 17, 7)
4. Put ____ counters in the ones column and ____ in the tens column. Add and subtract in both columns.
