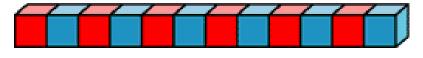


## **Figuring Out the Pattern**

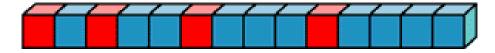
- 1. Connective cubes work great for putting together patterns but you can also use crayons and draw out your patterns on paper.
- 2. Start by putting together a simple pattern. The other person has to figure out the pattern. Example:



(Red, blue, red, blue...)

3. Next, put together harder patterns. The other person has to figure out the pattern and tell what the next pattern would look like.

## **Example:**



(Red always is one cube and blue you add one more than the last set of blue. So the next pattern would be one red and five blue.)
