

Understanding and Hearing

- O Pays attention to a short story and answers simple questions about it.
- O Everyone who knows child thinks he/she hears well.
- O Hears and understand most of what is said at home and in school.

Talking

- Voice sounds clear like other children's.
- O Uses sentences that give lots of details (e.g., "I like to read my books").
- O Tells stories that stick to a topic.
- O Communicates easily with other children and adults.
- O Says most sounds correctly except a few like I, s, r, v, z, ch, sh, th.
- O Uses adult-like grammar.
